Dear Parents/Carers,

I am writing to remind you of the details regarding the Young Voices concert due to take place on Thursday 12<sup>th</sup> January 2017 at Sheffield Arena.

We will be leaving school at 12.30pm following an early school dinner or packed lunch. Please provide your child with a disposable packed tea and a drink (not fizzy). The children will attend an afternoon rehearsal followed by a tea break and the concert will start at 7.00pm. Once finished we will arrive back in Cliffe between 10.30 -11.30pm. A text will be sent to parents once we get within 15 minutes of the school. **Please note that all children will be returning on the coach, it will not be possible to pick them up from Sheffield.**

Due to ever rising transport costs a voluntary contribution of £10 per pupil would be very much appreciated to help cover the cost of the coach. Please make payment via ParentPay.

Should your child have a Young Voices t-shirt they will be required to bring it into school on the morning of the concert. Alternatively a plain white t-shirt will be ideal.

Please note that Mr Price will be leading the trip, with 3 other staff members. Pupils should not bring money, cameras or electrical devices on the trip. The school banner should give you our position inside the arena.

As in previous years, because of the late evening, we allow the children a later start to the school day the following morning, if required. Therefore, we ask that children (and any siblings) be in school for final registration by 10.30am. Could you please make sure that if your child is going to be late into school on the Friday, that Mr Price is aware the previous day whether or not they are going to be a school dinner or a packed lunch.

Young Voices have asked that we help to stop people going hungry in the Sheffield and Yorkshire area. We would be very grateful if you could give your child a tin (eg. soup, meat, fish and / or veg), sugar, rice or dried pasta from your kitchen. This will be collected on the way into the concert at the Sheffield Arena by the charity FareShare ([www.fareshare.org.uk](http://www.fareshare.org.uk)) which fights hunger in the UK. The food will be distributed to organisations supporting vulnerable people in your community. We are sure that the Young Voices children will be very proud to help the disadvantaged.
